REVIEW OF ROCK LOBSTER COMMERCIAL CONCESSION AREA REGULATIONS

The purpose of this letter is to invite you to participate in the review of spiny rock lobster commercial concession area regulations by providing a submission on the proposals outlined below.

Background

"Concession areas" are areas where commercial fishers can harvest rock lobster at a smaller size than the 54/60 mm tail width minimum legal size. There are three rock lobster concession areas in New Zealand: CRA 3 (Gisborne), CRA 7 (Otago) and CRA 8 (Southern). Each concession area was introduced for different reasons, at different times and each contains varying regulations.

Proposed Management Options

The Ministry of Fisheries (the Ministry) is seeking comments on the following management options. The options propose to retain or remove each set of concession regulations based on an analysis of costs and benefits.

CRA 3	Option 1A Retain the CRA 3 Concession Area regulations	Option 1B Remove the CRA 3 Concession Area regulations
CRA 7	Option 2A Retain the CRA 7 Concession Area regulations	Option 2B Remove the CRA 7 Concession Area regulations
CRA 8	Option 3A Retain the CRA 8 Concession Area regulations	Option 3B Remove the CRA 8 Concession Area regulations
